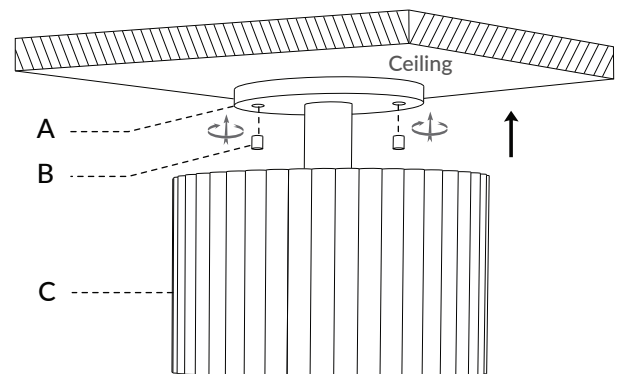
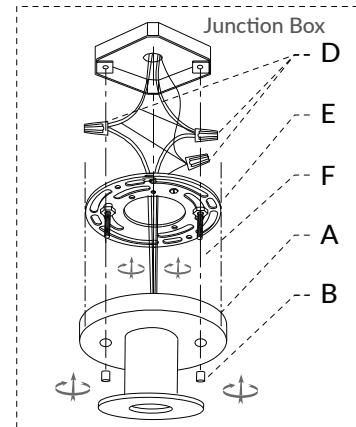


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

TAMBO SEMI-FLUSH MOUNT

1. Carefully remove all lamp parts from the box and spread on a flat clean surface.
2. Cut the excess cord to keep the power wire 12" longer than the length that you will ultimately need. Insert the cord into the holes of the cord clip set on the cord. Split the end of the power supply wire 3-1/2" from the end and strip the plastic cover off the wire about 1/2".
3. Attach the crossbar (E) to the ceiling outlet junction box using two screws (B). Connect the white wire from the fixture to the white wire of the supply circuit and connect the black wire from the fixture to the black supply circuit using connectors (D).
4. Wrap the fixture green ground wire around the green screw one full turn and tighten the screw. Connect the remaining end of the fixture ground wire to the supply ground wire.
5. Raise the canopy (A) to the ceiling and secure in place with crossbar (E) by screws (B).
7. Your fixture has been equipped with a 23W LED, 2700K, 90+CRI energy-saving LED module..
8. Enjoy the beautiful light.



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless the plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.

IMPORTANTES INSTRUCCIONES DE SEGURIDAD

Esta lampara tiene un enchufe polarizado (una navaja es mas ancha que la otra) como forma de seguridad para reducir el riesgo de un shock electrico. Este enchufe polarizado entrara en una conexi3n solo de un lado. Si el enchufe no entra en la conexi3n trate al reverso. Si aun asi no entra, contacte a un electricista calificado. Nunca use una extension a menos que el enchufe pueda ser conectado completamente. No altere el enchufe.



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
